

2010 Seigakuin University's Educational and Financial Support Program

Press Release: Brief Summary

Seigakuin University's motto is "Come and Achieve Your Potential" 「入って伸びる大学」. In order to pursue our goals, we have developed a comprehensive student support system. Consequently, in coping with rapid changes in the economic conditions facing many applicants, we have determined to provide appropriate aid to help meet the students' needs. Parents naturally have a sense of contentment and pride in sending their children to universities, and students can experience a personally rewarding and autonomous campus lifestyle at Seigakuin University. Seigakuin University celebrated its 20th anniversary last year. The administration then designed the "Emergency Budgetary Assistance for Entrance Exam" system in the general entrance examination committee and subsequently implemented it, and we will continue to provide the support outlined below for the 2010 Seigakuin University applicants.

Brief Summary

Targeted Students

- Applicants who submitted the proper application form and passed one of the following exams: the entrance exam for designated schools' recommended students, the general recommended student entrance exam, the self-recommended student entrance exam, or the AB general entrance exams.

Support Program Contents

Support upon School Entry

A. Monthly Tuition Payment Installment Plan

- Review based on applicants' needs and qualifications
- Students who applied for "Japan Student Services Organization [JASSO] Category 1 Scholarship Loan" 「学生支援機構第一種」 assistance while in high school and qualified, may use the scholarship loan subsequently provided, and this payment can be applied to the recipient's tuition every month.

B. Entrance Fee Waiver

- Review based on applicants' needs and qualifications
- Total of 40 students will be awarded the Entrance Fee Waiver each year

Support after School Entry [AB General Entrance Exams]

Refer to the "Campus Self-support System Plan" regarding the following:

- Applicants can receive prior consultation regarding their tuition payments with reference to the General Incorporated Association's "Student Support Foundation" 「生活サポート基金」 (also family financial support, projected income simulations, lending facilities, etc.).
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Self-support _____ Maximum 4 semester- (2 year-) scholarship loan, according to individual circumstances and needs.

These will be reviewed separately each semester.

Seigakuin University's Financial Support Section will provide support as needed after students have entered the school. "Self-supporting" students will be asked to receive consultation from the General Incorporated Association's "Student Support Foundation" 「生活サポート基金」.

Announcement Notification of the names of the applicants who passed the review

* Applicants who decide not to enter Seigakuin University will still be assessed the regular school entrance examination fee.

How to apply

Submit the appropriate application form along with the entrance examination application documents. Students who have received a "Japan Student Services Organization Category 1 Student Loan" 「日本学生支援機構一種」 should submit an official letter of approval (copy). 【Reference】Campus Self-support System Plan

1. Consignment of Outside Business Activities

The goal of this system is to provide "Support to pay tuition by oneself." Specifically, preparation will be made to help families with their finances to order to pay the tuition. We entrust the following tasks to professionals outside of the Seigakuin University organization: "provision of family financial consulting services for students and guarantors," "provision of family budget simulations," and "determination of lending facilities for guarantors."

(Affected) Students who have difficulty paying their tuition. Whatever the circumstances, students who have trouble paying their tuition can apply for this program.

(Outsourcing company) The General Incorporated Association's "Student Support Foundation" 「生活サポート基金」

(Outsourcing contents)

1. Provide family financial consulting services for our students and their guarantors
2. Provide family budget simulations for our students and their guarantors
3. Determine lending facilities for our students and their guarantors
4. Provide lifestyle guidance regarding school activities such as open campus, assembly hour, etc.

2. Seigakuin Self-Support System

This system supports students who have to pay their tuition by themselves.

(Contents)

1. Apply for the Monthly Tuition Payment Installment Plan

We normally ask for the tuition to be paid in one lump sum per semester. However, if you apply for this plan, you can pay the tuition in monthly installments. For example, if you have a scholarship loan from the “Japan Student Services Organization” 「学生支援機構」, this payment can be applied to your tuition every month.

2. Special Scholarship

We will provide loans equal to a maximum of 4 semesters' tuition based on the student's “Campus Design Plan” [“Customized Financial Plan”]. This special scholarship is for students who have difficulty paying their tuition through a normally scheduled payment plan or a monthly installment plan. The amount of the scholarship will be determined on the basis of student need and is for 1 to 4 semesters.

(Conditions) Submit a “Campus Design Plan” any time prior to graduation, and, in case of borrowing money to pay your tuition, submit a repayment plan at the time of graduation.
